

Community Council Meeting Minutes

January 20, 2016

Welcome: Mr. Hadley, Raquelle Johnson was not in attendance.

Accreditation:

We have the results of our surveys in. There was a ranking from 1-4 and these are the results.

Staff: 3.87

Parents 3.77

Students 3.53

All the results were really close and looked good. Andrea has been working hard on the accreditation and we will be submitting it to the state on February 6.

Accreditation will be March 10 & 11. We will be using our Laker Waves time to explain the accreditation process to the students.

Attendance:

Our attendance percentages are coming down. We have been doing hall sweeps and making the students more aware of the attendance issues. 2nd quarter there were 5,286 missed days of school which put us at 92% attendance.

Our grade distribution for the quarter was 50% A's with 92% passing grades.

All of this is part of our Cone Initiative. We will be meeting as a cone on Jan. 21 and we will be talking about transition meetings. When Special Education has students come to the high school they have a transition meeting with the teachers to help the students and see what they need to be on track. We are going to try and get that same kind of meeting for our students coming from the Jr. High's that are already deficient on credit. We will be talking to the elementaries at our cone meeting to see how they do it successfully.

Mission Statement:

We have decided to come up with a new mission statement that is a little shorter and has the key words that are important to us. We have had input from the faculty and staff and this is what we have come up with.

We will be getting new drains and in the spring they will start the work on our new track.
