Larry Hadley:

Membership:

Plans:

Mr. Hadley went over our Trustland plan.

Goal #1: Sage Data. Our school grade was a B. ELA: 10th grade above district average. 11th grade was a little below the district average. Math: 10th grade was average, 11th grade was below. Science: All subjects improved but still below average.

Goal #2: College and Career Readiness.

Plan is to go to the Jr. High's to help with readiness so when students get to the high school they are not behind in credits. Will be involving the entire cone including elementary schools.

Attendance rate is at 92.2%. Goal is to have it at 94%. Will target students with attendance problems to help get them to school.

Goal #3: Staffing Quality through PD. Every teacher will get a score this year.

Goal #4: Technology. We have 3 different leases that have been paid for this year out of trustlands for a total of \$17,900.00. We have 2 potable labs and have had the building wired for more access points to increase the bandwidth.

Plan Adjustment: Would like to put money into a Character or student incentive budget. The incentive would be for student grades, attendance and citizenship. They would have to get a 3.0 or above, have no attendance credit loss and no U's on their citizenship. Every quarter there will be a prize for those students who achieve those goals. The first quarter will be a t-shirt, different color for each grade. Debbie Stevens motioned for there to be an adjustment to the plan. Sherri Porter seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Accreditation:

Accreditation will be held on March 10th. There will be surveys for both the Community Council and PTSA to fill out. We will add one extra Community Council meeting in February for accreditation.
