FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

Night: There will be a FAFSA night session held during Parent Teacher Conference on February 21 from 5:00-7:00pm in the Testing Lab. This is for both students and parents. You must know your social security number or your tax ID number to fill out the application. You also will need to provide your driver's license number. Please come and we can help you get your FAFSA completed.

ACT will be held April 14, 2018 and the **deadline for registration** for March 9th. Information and test prep booklets are available in the Counseling Center.

Juniors: The State wide ACT test will be given to all Juniors on February 27th. If you don't have a study guide please come by the Counseling Center and pick one up. Also, you can access ACT test prep by going to <http://actstudent.org>.

Juniors Girls' State and Boys' State applications are available in the Counseling Center see Ms. Fonseca. It's a great opportunity to see firsthand how the government works in action. You also will have an opportunity to earn Political Science 2920 credit from Weber State University.
