# Bonneville High School Grade - “D”

Pre 16/17 State Law: School grades fall where they may. (C/B/C)

16/17 State Law: No more than 20% of schools can receive an A or B grade.

This has since been changed. No letter grade 17/18 as new program looked at.

Sufficient Growth - Above level set by state (40%)

2013 - 2016: SAGE was ELA 10/11, Math II/III, Chem/Bio/Phy

2017: SAGE was ELA 10, Math II, Chem/Bio/Phy (no Chem 1110)

We lost an opportunity to show growth in 2 classes with more mature students.

# How we are scored...

Proficiency - 1 point for each % proficient up to 100 points per subject. (33/26/28)

Growth -  $\frac{1}{2}$  point for each student showing sufficient growth up to 50 pts (28/27/22)

If below proficient last year,  $\frac{1}{2}$  point if show sufficient growth up to 50 pts (27/24/23)

Points assigned for graduation rate (%) up to 150 points (136)

Points for students who are “CCR” as shown on ACT up to 150 points (30)

404/900 = 45%

A: 100% - 64%    B: 63% - 51%    C: 50% - 43%    D: 42% - 40%    F: 39% or less

Grade lowered one letter if participation is less than 95% (98% - 7% opt out)
